Roger A. Watson was born in Carenage, Trinidad & Tobago and now resides in Atlanta, GA. After the passing of his first wife Magdalene Jessy Watson in 2011, he was commissioned by God in October 2012 to tell the story of the great love they experienced and the life they shared. His vision is to help people develop Championship Relationships through the concept of Agaphileros (Agape-Phileo-Eros) and The Love and Life Ministries, Inc.

Roger A. Watson became a born-again Christian in 1986 at Carenage Pentecostal Church in Trinidad under then Pastor Michael Braithwaite. Upon migrating to the United States of America in 1989 he joined Ebenezer Temple Church in Hartford Connecticut under the leadership of the late Pastors Evan and Mildred Spencer. In 1991 he joined Bible Way Temple Church in Hartford under Apostle T. Allen Stringer. He moved from Connecticut in 1994 to attend college in Georgia and has lived there since. Upon arriving in Atlanta he joined World Changers Church International where he served under the leadership of Dr. Creflo and Taffi Dollar. There he served as a Vision Keeper and also in the Prison Ministry.

In 2010 he answered the call to assist at a friend's ministry called International Ministries 2000 Church and he was ordained as a Minister that year by the late Bishop Gordon Williams and Pastor Delores Williams.

Roger and Magdalene had 2 beautiful daughters. After she passed in 2011, he returned to World Changers Church International to complete the healing

process. In 2017 he was married to Maria P. Camejo, his co-laborer in the ministry.

Roger has written 3 books: “Agaphileros A: Love the way it is supposed to be”; “Agaphileros B: If loving you is right, I don’t want to be wrong”; and “Agaphileros C: 8 Movements to the Love of a Lifetime” and loves counseling others about Love.
